Like all seahorses **Jubilee** is very majestic and has a coronet on the top of her head. Seahorses are very serene and sit regally in the seagrass and other areas of the sea where they live. As a representative of these amazing little horses of the sea we hope you will adopt **Jubilee**, so that we can help them by studying them in the wild, and ensuring that the protection that we got for them through the Wildlife and Countryside Act is enacted upon, and we have seahorses here in the UK for another 60 years, in time for the next jubilee.

**Adopt a Seahorse:** help us to help them, by adopting a **Jubilee** you will be paying towards the work of The Seahorse Trust, in its research, studying Seahorses in the wild and in captivity so that we can work in partnership with others to make sure Seahorses have a better future in the UK and abroad.
